# The Compost Education Centre is Hiring a Summer Education Assistant!

The Compost Education Centre (CEC) is a charitable, not-for-profit organization that provides composting, organic gardening, and conservation education to residents of the Capital Regional District. The Summer Education Assistant (SEA) reports to the Executive Director and works closely with the Child and Youth Education Manager. The SEA supports the CEC's education programs offered on-site and in schools. The SEA will have opportunities to empower learners in ecological stewardship through learning how to compost, grow their own food, and care for local ecosystems while gaining valuable skills in delivering environmental education relating to sustainability, conservation, and protection.

All work will be conducted with adherence to current best COVID-19 safety practices.

Positions are contingent on Federal funding from Canada Summer Jobs. Start dates and contract durations may vary from what is listed in this posting.

#### **Duties include:**

Program delivery and support (40%)

- Support engaging delivery of workshops, summer camps site tours, and other demonstrations;
- Travel to and from schools, daycares, and sites to provide workshops; and
- Preparation, set up, and take down workshops on- and off site.

# Program development (40%)

- Support the development of education programs and educational materials for children and vouth:
- Review workshops and ensure they are engaging and age-appropriate; and
- Create new hands-on and age-appropriate ecological programming.

### Office assistance (20%)

- Respond in friendly and timely ways to public inquires (calls, emails, and social media);
- Sell seeds, composters, and other sustainability supplies;
- Assist with the successful promotion of programs via social media and direct email; and
- Assist with other ongoing programs and priorities as required.





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### Requirements

- A Class 5 Drivers License;
- Willingness to obtain a Standard First Aid and CPR-C certificate by start of contract;
- Willingness to obtain a Criminal Record Check with vulnerable sector search by start of contract;

- Demonstrated knowledge/enthusiasm of composting, waste reduction, ecological conservation, decolonizing food and agricultural systems, and/or soil health;
- Demonstrated experience as an educator including creating engaging and age-appropriate lesson plans for children;
- Ability to communicate well verbally and in writing; and
- Proficiency using online software such as Canva, Google Suite and Social Media.

- Ability to lift workshop supplies (30lbs) short distances (accommodations possible, please inquire); and
- Ability to work at a desk for several hours at a time (accommodations possible, please inquire).
